Medical research done in collaboration with its host institutions is engaged in the direct active conduct of research in conjunction with hospitals. Scientific research in the public interest and its objective with respect to intellectual property arising from its research activities is the dissemination of such property for public use on a non-discriminatory basis. The host institution should adopt policies and procedures to govern the ownership, assignment, and dissemination of its intellectual property. Its policies and procedures relating to Institute Intellectual property generally are set forth in this Intellectual Property Policy (the policy). Further policies and procedures relating to scientific research collaborations, materials transfer agreements, consulting, and other issues are set forth elsewhere and are not included in this Policy. But this is practically not practiced in Bangladesh.
